









How to Submit a Photo to Google Classrooms Using Your iPhone (Video on Next Page if Needed)

<p>1. Start by going into your classrooms app. You will see any upcoming assignments under your classes.</p>	<p>2. Select the class to access the stream. Scroll down to the assignment and into it. You can also access it from 'Classwork'</p>	<p>3. Any instructions will then appear. Select the arrow below them to 'add an attachment'</p>	<p>4. This screen will then show up. Now select '+ Add Attachment'</p>
			
<p>5. This screen will appear. Select 'Use Camera'. You can also pick a photo from your gallery.</p>	<p>6. This will bring you to your camera. Take a photo of your work from here. Ensure the photo is clear and orientated upwards. (Portrait). Then select the tick/ upload.</p>	<p>7. Your photo will then upload. Once it's finished you will see this screen. If you have more than one photo you can add another by selecting 'add attachment' again.</p>	<p>8. Select 'Hand In' when your photos are uploaded. This screen will then show up. You must then click 'Hand In' again. The assignment will then be submitted.</p>
